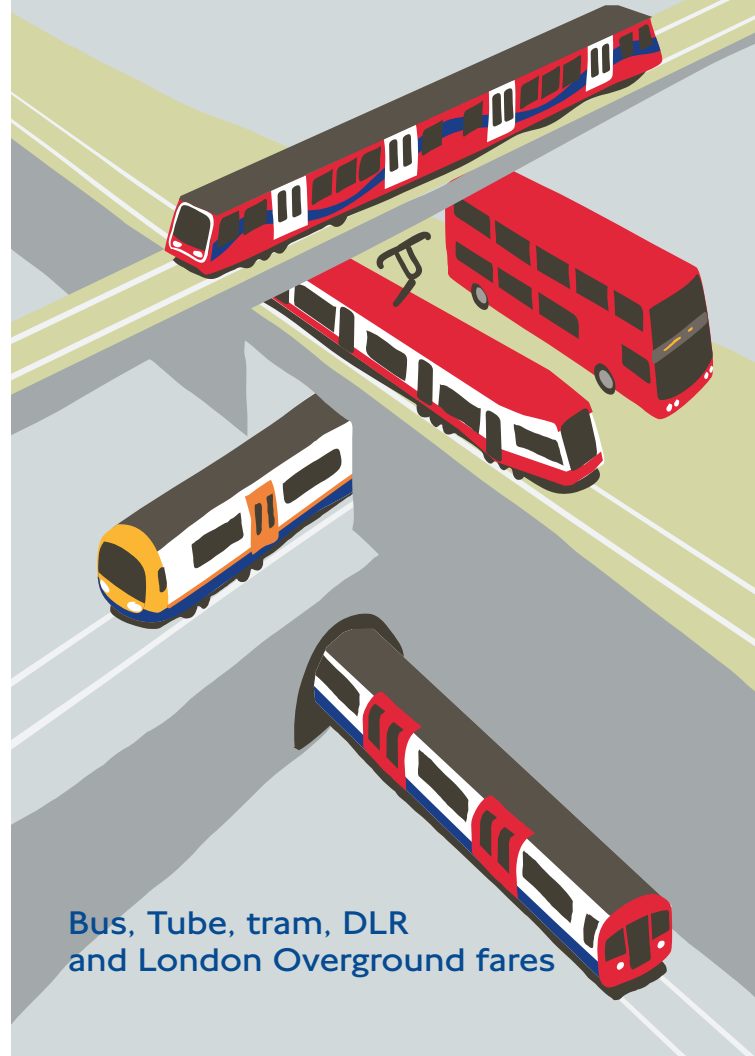

YOUR fares and tickets from 2 January 2008

Good news! From 2 January 2008 all bus and tram fares are frozen as are Oyster and cash single fares on the Tube and DLR.

We are also extending the benefits of using Oyster:

- Oyster pay as you go can be used on the new London Overground network
- Oyster pay as you go will be accepted on more National Rail services
- The number of Oyster Ticket Stops is to be increased throughout 2008 making it even easier to add tickets and/or cash onto Oyster
- From 5 January, there will no longer be a £5 administration fee for first issues of 5-10, 11-15 and 16+ Oyster photocard

The benefits of using Oyster:

Oyster continues to be the easiest way to travel around London:

- Adult cash bus and tram single fares cost £2 but with Oyster are 90p at all times
- Adult cash Tube single fares within Zone 1 cost £4 but with Oyster remain at £1.50
- The adult daily cap for unlimited travel with pay as you go is less than the cost of the equivalent Day Travelcard
- The single fare for 11-15s on the Tube and DLR is 50p a journey, with a daily cap of £1 for unlimited travel within Zones 1-9

Using YOUR Oyster

When using Oyster to pay as you go on the Tube, DLR, London Overground or on National Rail where pay as you go is valid, you must always touch in, by placing your card flat on the yellow reader, at the start and touch out at the end of your journey. This is to ensure that you pay the correct Oyster single fare. Failure to touch in and out correctly will result in you paying a maximum cash fare. This will not count towards your daily price cap

Travelcards stored on Oyster can be used within the zones paid for across National Rail services in London. If you make any trips outside the zones of your Travelcard, you can use cash to pay as you go provided that your journey starts and finishes at stations where Oyster pay as you go is valid.

When using a bus or tram, you must touch in at the start of your journey.

Please check for the green light when you touch in and/or out to ensure your Oyster card has been validated. If you continue to get a red light, ask a member of staff for advice.

If you do not hold a valid ticket, Travelcard or have enough cash to pay as you go for your entire journey you may receive a Penalty Fare or be prosecuted.



Travel discounts

There are some great travel discounts available which are listed briefly below. For full Terms and Conditions visit tfl.gov.uk/fares or pick up a leaflet, available at most Tube stations and Oyster Ticket Stops.

Ten year olds and under travel free

- Accompanied children under 5 can travel free anywhere on the bus, Tube, tram, DLR and London Overground at any time.
- 5-10 year olds can travel free on buses and trams – no photocard is needed.
- 5-10 year olds can travel free on the Tube, DLR and London Overground with a 5-10 Oyster photocard. No Oyster photocard is needed if accompanied by an adult with a valid ticket, Oyster card or freedom pass.

Travel for 11-15 year olds

- Free travel on buses and trams for 11-15 year olds; 14-15 year olds need an Oyster photocard. From 1 June 2008, all 11-15 year olds will need an Oyster photocard to travel free on buses and trams.
- Child-rate Travelcard season tickets on the Tube, DLR and London Overground, and if using the tram at Wimbledon; an Oyster photocard is needed.

Travel for 16-18 year olds

- Free travel on buses and trams for those living in London and in full-time education, or on a work-based learning scheme plus half price travel on the Tube, DLR and London Overground; a valid 16+ Oyster photocard is needed.
- Half-price adult fares on buses, Tube, tram, DLR and London Overground for all other 16-17 year olds with a valid 16+ Oyster photocard.

Travel for 18+ students in full-time education

30% discount on adult-rate Bus Pass and Travelcard season tickets with a valid Oyster photocard if you are attending a college or school registered with TfL.

Bus and Tram Discount Card for Londoners on Income Support

Half price Oyster single fares and Bus Pass season tickets on buses and trams for Londoners on Income Support with the Bus and Tram Discount Card. You will need an Oyster card with your discount concession loaded onto it. Applicants must be 18+, living in London and must not be receiving any other travel concession.

New Deal photocard

Holders of New Deal photocards can benefit from child-rate Tube, DLR and London Overground tickets (including Travelcards), reduced-rate Bus Passes and can use Oyster to pay as they go at half the adult-rate. For season tickets and to pay as you go, you will need an Oyster card with your discount concession loaded onto it.

Oyster daily price capping

If you use Oyster to pay as you go on the Tube, DLR, London Overground and some National Rail services, the system will look at your journeys in a 24 hour period (from 0430 and before 0430 the next day) and the amount you pay will be less than the price of an equivalent Day Travelcard. If you also use buses or trams during this period these trips will be included in this price cap. Our aim is to ensure that Oyster always charges the lowest fare. Where it doesn't we will refund the difference.
